

NRC Card Renewal Policy

1. It is the cardholder's responsibility to renew the card a minimum of 6 weeks before the expiry date that is shown on the front of the card.
2. It is the cardholder's responsibility to ensure that their contact details are current. PLASA will send renewal reminders via e-mail 1 month prior to the cards expiry date.
3. Cards will be renewed from the original date of expiry.
4. PLASA will offer a grace period of 3 months following the card's expiry date at no extra charge.
5. Renewals received beyond 3 months and up to 6 months will be subject to a late renewal fee.
6. Renewals received beyond 6 months will be subject to the late renewal fee and the cardholder will be required to supply additional evidence of continued work practice.
7. Renewals received after 2 years from the original date of expiry will require the cardholder to re-register to the scheme and re-take an assessment at the current fees.

Evidence of continued proficiency is mandatory for all applications

Late renewal fees or re-assessments may be waived or re-considered at the discretion of a Director of PLASA and the Chair of the Rigging Advisory Group, if the applicant fits the following circumstances:

- The applicant has had a medical condition which has precluded him/her from undertaking Rigging. Evidence to support this will be requested.
