By placing a bid, each bidder agrees to the following auction rules . . .

3. By placing a bid you are entering into an agreement to purchase the item at the offered price.
4. The highest bid will be deemed to be the winner. In the extreme case of where an entry error has occurred, please contact us for the retraction of your bid. If this occurs, we reserve the right to offer the item to the second highest bidder.
5. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds. The item is sold "as is." LSi/PLASA has attempted to describe the item correctly, but in no event shall be responsible for the correctness of descriptions, genuineness, or condition of the item.
6. The item has been donated kindly and as such any respective terms and conditions are applicable.
7. The item has not been value appraised.
8. Details of the winning bidder will be passed on to #WeMakeEvents for collection of the funds.
9. Following receipt of payment and your vehicle details, the item can be collected from PLASA or posted (by prior agreement via email). The registration number will then be transferred onto your vehicle and you will receive details from DVLA in due course.
